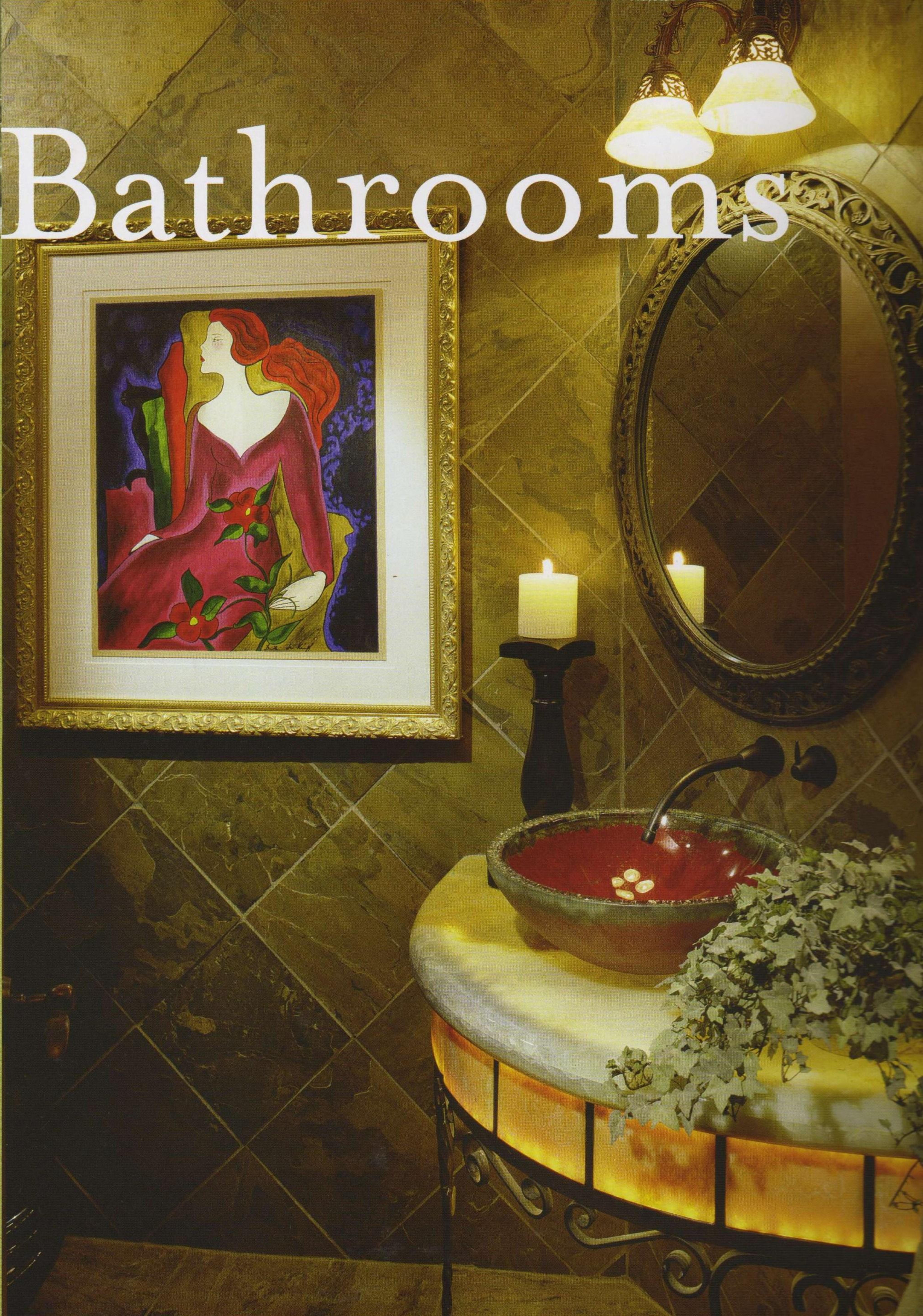

Place your favorite comfy chair near the fireplace and make sure you have adequate lighting to read. A decorative iron fire grill sits in front of this fireplace with candles glowing nearby, casting palm tree patterns on the wall that seem to mimic the curtain panel.



Bathrooms

Right: The multi-colored basin perfectly complements the slate-covered walls and floor and joins the painting in adding a dash of color and artistry. A light under the counter is an interesting design element that works well with the mirror, faucet, and wall sconces.





The generous use of ranch wood and slate in this bathroom requires strong accessories. Multiple framed mirrors and table lamps give height and dimension to the space. The vanity between the sinks is raised to accommodate a chair comfortably. Natural light from windows above evokes a subterranean ambiance.



The contrasting colors of the square-patterned floor mimic the design of the wooden ceiling beams. Slender arched windows marry the upper and lower spaces and frame outside views, and the use of tall trees and decorative curtains balance the room's colors and patterns.
